

PMI (Purchase Manager Index)

A PMI reading above 50 percent (red line below) indicates that the manufacturing economy is generally expanding and below 50 percent means it is contracting.

Commentary

Purchasing activity in the manufacturing sector expanded in February for the second month in a row, and the economy grew for the 130th consecutive month. Growth in Production, Backlog and Exports offset contractions in New Orders, Raw Material Inventories, Employment, Prices, Imports and Supplier Deliveries.

Unemployment Rate

Unemployment rate is traditionally defined as the percentage of the total labor force that is actively looking for gainful employment.





Commentary

In February, the unemployment rate and the total number of unemployed persons were changed little at 3.5% and 5.8 million, respectively. Total nonfarm payroll employment rose by 273,000 driven by job gains in health care and social assistance, food services and drinking places, government and construction.

Industrial Production and Capacity Utilization

The Production Index (in red below) measures real output and is expressed as a percentage of real output in a base year, currently 2007. The Capacity Index (in green below), which is an estimate of sustainable potential output, is also expressed as a percentage of real output in 2007.





Commentary -

Industrial production and utilization rose 0.6% and 0.4%, respectively, in February. At 109.6% of its 2012 average, total industrial production in February was unchanged from a year earlier. Manufacturing output inched up 0.1% in February as large gains in motor vehicle output offset a large drop in civilian aircraft output, and manufacturing utilization remained unchanged.

Producer Price Index (PPI) and Consumer Price Index (CPI)

The PPI measures the average change over time in prices received (price changes) by producers for domestically produced goods, services and construction. The CPI measures changes in the prices paid by urban consumers for a representative basket of goods and services.

Commentary -

CPI for all items rose 0.1% in February, as notable increases in the shelter and food indexes more than offset the 2.0% decline in the energy index. PPI for final demand fell 0.6% in February, driven largely by the 0.9% decrease in prices for final demand goods (over one-third of which was attributable to the 6.5% drop in gasoline prices). The index for final demand services also moved down 0.3%.


Sector Index Performance


Comparative Sector Index Performance (Last Twelve Months)

Comparative Subsector LTM EV/Revenue



Commentary

During the last twelve months, our subsector indices had a mean EV/Revenue of 1.6x (i.e., red line) and a median of 1.4x (i.e., yellow line). Of the subsectors, Semiconductor Capital Equipment had the high multiple at 3.9x and Technical Services and Industrial Recycling had the low multiples at 0.6x.

Comparative Subsector LTM EV/EBTIDA



Commentary

During the last twelve months, our subsector indices had a mean EV/EBITDA of 11.0x and a median of 10.6x. Of the subsectors, Measurement, Control & Testing Devices had the high multiple at 18.7x and Vehicle Parts & Supplies had the low multiple at 6.0x.

Comparative Subsector LTM Gross Margin



Commentary

During the last twelve months, our subsector indices had a mean Gross Margin of 26.8% and a median of 24.8%. Of the subsectors, Measurement, Control & Testing Devices and Semiconductor Capital Equipment had the high margins at 44.7%, and Technical Services had the low margin at 11.0%.

Comparative Subsector LTM EBITDA Margin




Index Subsector LTM EV/EBITDA vs. EBITDA Margin*

Index Subsector LTM EV/EBITDA vs. Gross Margin*







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
